The Discretionary Grant is intended to meet the AgriSETA skills needs as set out in the Sector Skills Plan (SSP), Strategic Plan, priorities in the National Skills Development Plan, Economic Reconstruction and Recovery Plan (ERRP) as well as the Master Plans in Agriculture. In addition, the allocation of discretionary grant funds intends to improve the supply of qualified and competent workers for Hard to Fill Vacancies.
